Early Intervention Teacher (Apprentice / Trained)

As an Early Intervention Teacher, you will be planning, organizing, and implementing appropriate instructional programs to address the learning needs of the students aged 2 months to 6 years old. You will guide and encourage students to develop and fulfill their potential in both curricular and extracurricular activities. A key aspect of working in this field is identifying individual needs and being responsible for creating a safe, stimulating, and supportive learning environment.

Key responsibilities:

- a) Develop, write, and implement Individualized Educational Plans (IEPs) for a caseload of students and provide timely and regular reports on student development.
- b) Plan, prepare, and deliver instructional activities that facilitate active learning experiences both within and outside of classrooms.
- c) Identify and utilize different instructional resources and methods to support the different learning needs of students.
- d) Prepare and provide appropriate varied strategies / activities for generalization in home and community settings.
- e) Work in collaboration and partnership with parents to maximise the learning objectives of students.
- f) Work with other professionals such as Social Workers, Allied Health Professionals, and Psychologists.
- g) Maintain accurate and complete records of student progress and development.

Requirements:

- a) Full GCE 'A' Levels including GP or KI / Local Polytechnic Diploma with min of 5 'O' Levels including English & Math (for Apprentice Teacher)
- b) Advanced Diploma in Early Childhood Intervention (Special Needs) awarded by Ngee Ann Polytechnic (for Trained Teacher)
- c) Good ICT, oral, and written English communication skills
- d) Able to work in a trans-disciplinary team of professionals to deliver quality services to students
- e) Able to lift and carry students and equipment when required
- f) Passionate to develop students with disabilities to their fullest potential
